Mat 6:6 Jesus promises us a reward in prayer:

"But when you pray, go into your room, close the door and pray to your Father, who is unseen. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you"



Jesus further promises a reward in fasting:

"But when you fast, put oil on your head and wash your face, so that it will not be obvious to others that you are fasting, but only to your Father, who is unseen; and your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you." (Matt 6:17-18)



Jesus is not teaching on whether we should fast or not. He is assuming we will fast and teaching us how to do it and especially how NOT to do it.

TURE SO OFTEN FOCUSES ON OUR ACCOMPLISHMENTS, I ABILITIES AND PRIDE RESULTS:

- Gen 3 Adam & Eve in the garden.
- Gen 11:4 The Tower of Babel.
- 2 Kings 5 Naaman the Leper
- Isa 29:13 People of Israel (Matt 15:7-9)
- Matt 6:1,5,16 The Pharisees: "to be seen by others



FASTING GIVES US AN OPPORTUNITY TO HUMBLE OURSELVES BEFORE GOD:

• Ezra 8:21 "Then I proclaimed a fast there... that we might <u>humble ourselves</u> before our God, to seek from him a safe journey for ourselves, our children, and all our goods."

• Psalm 35:13

• 1 Peter 5:6



If someone finds out you are fasting, you haven't sinned. The value of your fast is not destroyed if someone notices that you have skipped lunch!

- **BEING SEEN FASTING** and **FASTING TO BE SEEN** are not the same.
- Being seen fasting is a mere external event.
- Fasting TO BE SEEN is a self-exalting motive of the heart.

GOD IS A GOD OF REWARDS:

- Isa 30:18 "longs to be compassionate"
- Heb 11:6 "rewards those who seek Him"



Sometimes we see those rewards in this life, sometimes we may need an eternal perspective:

- David Psalm 73 the wicked seem to prosper and righteous struggle......
- BUT then David sees the eternal perspective: Psalm 73:16-17



5 CROWNS FOR REWARDS IN BIBLE

- 1. The imperishable crown: 1 Cor. 9:24,25.
- 2. *The crown of rejoicing*: 1 Thess. 2:19, 20. & Dan 12:3
- 3. The crown of life: James 1:12, Rev 2:8-11
- 4. The crown of righteousness: 2 Tim. 4:8.
- 5. The crown of glory: 1 Pet. 5:1-4.
