

1 Corinthians 10:31: "So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God."








- **GLORY** is a fascinating word = "heavy," as in a heavy rock. Glory carries weight.
- God's glory was once localized in a small, sacred space, the tabernacle (Exodus 40:34)
 THINK: Indiana Jones, Raiders of Lost Ark
- **NOW** With the coming of the Holy Spirit, glory now resides in every Christian. We as individuals and corporately together are God's temple (1 Corinthians 3:16; 6:19).

1 Corinthians 10:33: ^['] don't just do what is best for me" (NLT) "... not seeking my own good ..."
