

THE MESSAGE OF 1 PETER

WHY FOLLOWERS OF JESUS CAN PRAISE GOD:

- 1.because followers of Jesus have a living hope (1:3-5)
- 2.because followers of Jesus have a faith that is refined in trials (1:6-9)
- 3.because followers of Jesus see the revelation of salvation (1:10-12)



WHY WAS HOPE IMPORTANT TO THESE PEOPLE?

- ISOLATION: viewed with great suspicion
- EXCLUSION: lifestyle was different, wouldn't participate in idol worship
- PERSECUTION: blamed for problems in society



WHY DOES THIS LIVING HOPE BRING ENCOURAGEMENT?

The "inheritance" is described as something that:

- death can't destroy it (incorruptible) CAN NEVER
 PERISH
- evil cannot pollute it (undefiled) CAN NEVER SPOIL
- time can't diminish its value CAN NEVER FADE



"THIS INHERITANCE IS KEPT IN HEAVEN FOR YOU" 1 Peter 1:4

 The word translated "kept" is a military word that means "guarded, shielded", used to describe the soldiers guarding a city.

- The tense of the verb reveals that we are constantly being guarded by God, assuring us that we shall safely arrive in heaven.
- Indicates something in progress, a continuous process of protection.
 Literally, who continue to be guarded.



SO WHAT SHOULD YOU DO?

The word "grace" is used in every chapter of 1 Peter:

1:2, 10, 13; 2:19 3:7; 4:10; 5:5, 10, 12.

Grace is God's generous favour to those who don't deserve it.
