Living for God means we should be using our gifts TO SERVE FAITHFULLY






FEELING OVERWHELMED, UNAPPRECIATED?

Living for God means we should be using our gifts IN GOD'S STRENGTH



STRENGTH = FORCE TO OVERCOMING IMMEDIATE RESISTANCE.

- Our natural inclination is not to serve but to be served,
- Watch what happens to your reactions when someone tells you what to do!
- We have to overcome, by Gods strength, our reluctance and resistance to look after number 1 and simply protect ourselves.



KEY IDEA OF "GRACE" IN USING OUR GIFTS (ROMANS 12:6-8)

Grace is used in a number of ways in the bible:

- to describe Gods free gift of forgiveness that is available to all,
- to describe the favour of Gods presence with the faith community
- to describe the power of God to enable us to serve Him.



Paul had a fierce work ethic:

- "far greater labours" than his detractors (2 Corinthians 11:23),
- "I worked harder than any of them" (1 Corinthians 15:10).
- "with all His energy...He powerfully works within me," (Colossians 1:29)
