

1. What is doubt?



Distazo (διστάζω) to doubt, to waver, or to hesitate δíς (dis) twice or double στάζω (stázō) to stand or to take a stand

Apistia (ἀπιστία) Unbelief, lack of faith, unfaithfulness



2. What causes doubt?



Truly God is good to Israel, to those who hearts are pure. But As for me, I almost lost my footing. My feet was slipping, and I was almost gone. For I envied the proud when I saw them prosper despite their wickedness. Psalm 73 1-3



Doubts come when what your mind knows becomes unreal to your heart because of what you are experiencing.



And so the people are dismayed and confused, drinking in all their words. "What does God know?" they ask. "Does the Most High even know what's happening?" Look at these wicked people-enjoying a life of ease while their riches multiply. Did I keep my heart pure for nothing? Did I keep myself innocent for no reason?

I get nothing but trouble all day long; every morning brings me pain. If I had really spoken this way to others, I would have been a traitor to your people. So I tried to understand why the wicked prosper. But what a difficult task it is! Psalm 73:10-16
